What happened on the Ninth of Av? A Historical Overview

The 9th of Av, Tisha b'Av, commemorates a list of catastrophes so severe it's clearly a day specially cursed by G-d. Over the centuries, terrible events have occured to the Jewish people on this date. Jews see this as another confirmation of the deeply held conviction that history isn't haphazard; events - even terrible ones - are part of a Divine plan and have spiritual meaning. The message of time is that everything has a rational purpose, even though we don't understand it.


The 2011-2012 YLMC THEME will be THE MITZVOT OF KASHRUT
